CAEDMON PRIZE FOR MEDIEVAL POETRY

*** To be eligible, the student must write one poem in all six styles

- 1. **Anglo-Saxon**: 4 stressed syllables per line; at least 2nd and 3rd stressed syllables must alliterate; poem must be at least one quatrain (4 lines) in length
- 2. **Ballad**: at least one quatrain; 1st and 3rd lines in iambic tetrameter, 2nd and 4th lines in iambic trimeter (see the hymn Amazing Grace for an example)
- 3. **Dante** / *terza rima*: at least three tercets (sets of three lines) using *terza rima* scheme (ABA, BCB, CDC, DED, EFE...) in iambic pentameter
- 4. Chaucer: at least three rhyming couplets in iambic pentameter
- 5. Petrarchan sonnet: iambic pentameter; rhyme scheme: ABBA, ABBA, CDCDCD
- 6. **Spenserian/Shakespearean sonnet**: iambic pentameter; rhyme scheme: ABAB, CDCD, EFEF, GG
