<b>Grade Reporting</b>	Standard grades are reported at the end of each term	Course is graded on a <b>pass/fail</b> basis only each term
<b>Feedback on writing</b>	Comments are given at each stage of the writing process	<b>No major written work is required</b> , so no comments are provided
<b>Defense Day</b>	Required participation in both December and May	Student does <b>not</b> participate in Defense Day
<b>Scriptorium Credit</b>	One <i>full</i> Scriptorium credit upon successful completion <u>*Parents can award any credit they deem appropriate*</u>	One <i>half</i> Scriptorium credit upon successful completion <u>*Parents can award any credit they deem appropriate*</u>
<b>Diploma Program</b>	Course <i>does</i> count toward Diploma Program	Course does <b>not</b> count toward Diploma Program
<b>Dual-Credit from Bryan College</b>	Student <i>is</i> eligible for dual-credit on applicable courses	Student is <b>not</b> eligible for dual-credit
<b>Academic Prizes</b>	Student is eligible for <i>all</i> Academic Prizes	Student is <b>not</b> eligible for the Lewis or Michelangelo Prizes but may earn all other academic prizes
<b>Graduation</b>	Student formally graduates from Scriptorium	Student does <b>not</b> formally graduate from Scriptorium
